# Electronic Service Technician

An electronic service technician interacts with customers and other workers; uses hand tools, hand power tools, testing equipment and specialty tools; applies electronic theory to electronic products; terminates and connects conductors and printed circuit boards contained within electronic products; maintains electronic products; troubleshoots and diagnoses problems in electronic products and services and repairs electronic products.
