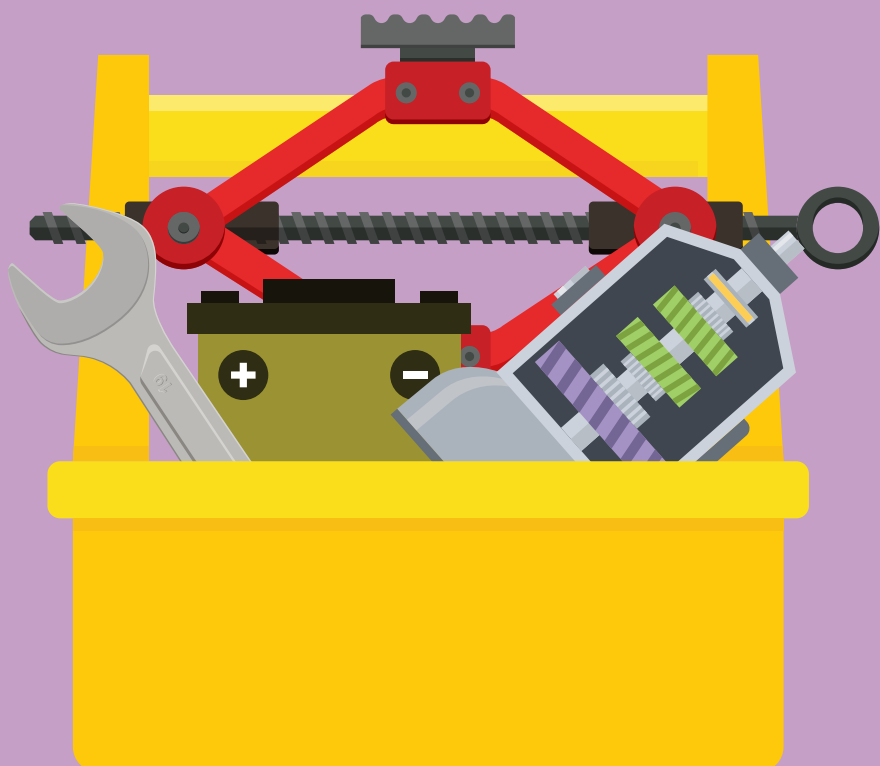

An auto body repairer repairs the body of motor vehicles, motor coaches, trucks or truck-trailers, including preparing vehicle for refinishing and repairing vehicle bodies and components.

- Compulsory trade
- 5,520 hours on the job + 480 hours of in-school training (levels 1, 2)
- Total of 6,000 hours (approximately three years)
- Certifying exam
